## **Note to all parents**

### **Usage and Care of Rainjackets**

Club Rain Jackets have been issued to all Club players once the annual Club registration fee has been paid. No direct charge has been made for these jackets, and they remain the property of Broadstone Football Club.

To ensure these jackets are kept in good condition and to maximise their life, you are kindly requested to observe the following rules and conditions:

- As soon as possible, please stitch a name tab bearing your child's name to the manufacturer's label on the inside of the collar.
- No other label or badge must be stitched or stuck to any part of the garment.
- The jacket must be worn to and from (and possibly during - as instructed by the team manager) all official Club events/matches (including training sessions).
- The jacket may be used for casual wear, but must be properly looked after.
- Players should always retrieve their own jacket following matches/training sessions, and are responsible for its safe keeping.
- The jacket should be kept clean and dry, and should be hung or neatly folded when not in use.
- In the event the jacket becomes wet or muddy, it should be lightly sponged with a damp cloth, and then hung to dry.
- Under no circumstances should the jacket be put in a washing machine or in hot water.
- The jacket is to be returned in good condition to the team manager in the event the player leaves the Club.
- **A charge will be made for replacement in the event the jacket is lost or damaged.**
